

THE GREAT PRAIRIE DRAWDOWN: JUDGES INSTRUCTIONS

SUBMISSIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED THROUGH *CONSENSUS*. BUT EACH JUDGE HAS THE PREROGATIVE OF PERSONALLY ADOPTING DRAWINGS THAT S/HE THINKS MERITORIOUS, EVEN IF THE OTHERS DON'T. BUT PLEASE DO NOT ABUSE THIS GESTURE.

1. IS THIS AN INDIGENOUS PLANT, INSECT, REPTILE, FISH, BIRD, OR OTHER ANIMAL IN KANSAS?
2. CAN IT BE EASILY RECOGNIZED? (SPECIES/GENUS)
3. IS THE PAPER REUSED AND/OR RECYCLED?
4. IS IT TRULY AN ORIGINAL? ARE THEY THE AUTHOR? OR DID SOMEONE ELSE DRAW IT? (WE WANT TO AVOID 1 PERSON SUBMITTING MORE THAN 1 ENTRY.)
5. WHERE DID THEY DRAW IT? CAN YOU TELL IF IT WAS DRAWN OUT IN NATURE, OR COPIED FROM A BOOK/INTERNET?
6. AUTHORS MUST SUBMIT THEIR DRAWING IN PERSON. NO SECOND PARTY SUBMISSIONS.
7. NO PITY DRAWINGS. THEY MUST ALL HAVE ENVIRONMENTAL AND ARTISTIC VALUE. (CAN YOU TELL IF THIS WAS DRAWN WITH LOVE? OR IF IT WAS DONE JUST TO GET A FREE DOLLAR?)
8. BE CAREFUL ABOUT ACCEPTING 1,000 SUNFLOWERS! (PLUS THEY ARE NOT IN BLOOM RIGHT NOW.) YOU CAN REJECT SOMETHING THAT IS BEING OVERLY REPEATED.
9. BUT YOU MAY MAKE EXCEPTIONS TO THESE RULES UNDER SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES, TO BE SPONTANEOUSLY DETERMINED IN THE MOMENT.
10. IF YOU SUSPECT THAT SOMEONE WILL USE THE FREE \$1 FOR AN ADDICTION, YOU MAY WITHHOLD THE PURCHASE. IF SOMEONE IS SUSPECT OF BEING DANGEROUS, YOU MAY ASK FOR HELP AND STOP THE PROCESS UNTIL THAT PERSON LEAVES THE PREMISES.
11. IF A PERSON PRESENTS SEVERAL DRAWINGS, YOU MAY ONLY PURCHASE 1, BUT PLEASE ENCOURAGE THEM TO DONATE THE REST.
12. PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT THE DRAWING HAS ALL THE REQUIRED INFORMATION ON ITS BACK.

THE JUDGES' TABLE WILL BE THE FIRST LINE OF DEFENSE. ACCEPTED PARTICIPANTS WILL THEN PROCEED TO THE TREASURER, TO HAND IN THEIR DRAWING IN EXCHANGE FOR \$1. THEIR DRAWING WILL THEN BE HANDED TO THE SCANNERS' TABLE, AND THEN INSTALLED ON THE WALL. PARTICIPANTS CAN WANDER AROUND, AND PICK UP FREE MATERIALS FROM ENVIRONMENTAL AND CULTURAL INSTITUTIONS.
